The Parrot SOUND SYSTEM is being launched with other products for the home this year also incorporating the company's *Bluetooth* expertise. Also on the way is the Parrot PHOTO VIEWER, the first *Bluetooth* digital picture frame allowing you to view photos taken on your mobile phone.



The Parrot SOUND SYSTEM consists simply of a pair of wireless speakers with built-in amplifier. This means that, apart from plugging each speaker into the mains, there are no wires between amplifier or speakers to trip over.
